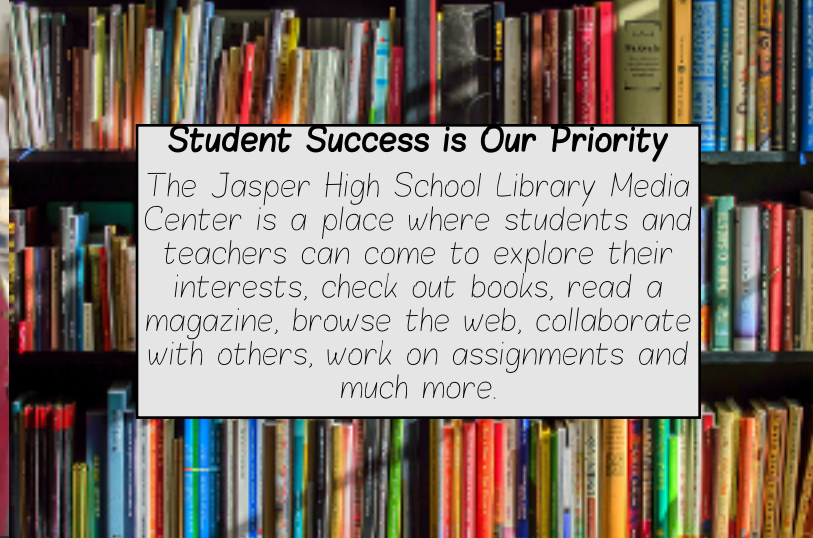

ABOUT YOUR LIBRARY

The mission of our library media program at Jasper High School is to support the curricula, increase student achievement, encourage reading, and help create lifelong learners and users of information through leadership, collaboration, quality resources, and current instructional strategies.

Students can access the LMC at any time during the school day for independent learning with permission from the instructional teacher.

Students may access the LMC at any time during school hours to check-out a book or renew reading materials.

Library Media Specialists are available throughout the day to assist you with your academic needs.

Fines and Fees

Students are allowed to check out two books at a time for a period of two weeks. After two weeks, the books are due to be returned or renewed. Books can be renewed a total of four times.

Reference books are available for student and teacher use. Teachers may check out reference books for two weeks at a time. Students may use reference material while they are visiting the media center, but they may not remove them from the media center.

Students are not charged a fee for late returns. However, students will be charged twenty dollars for books not returned or severely damaged.

Library Media Center Schedule

The JHS Library Media Center operates under a flexible schedule that is created through collaboration between the Library Media Specialists and instructional teachers, and is supported and encouraged by the administrators. Opening hours are from 7:20am to 3:20pm on regular school days.

Checking Out Materials

Students are allowed to check out up to two books at a time. Special consideration will be made in the event of research papers and other academic assignments. Books can be kept for a two week period before they need to be returned or renewed. Renewals and returns can be processed from the circulation desk in the library. There are numerous reference materials available as well. However, reference books may not be removed from the library. Teachers may check out books as needed.
